



RE: T.R.U.E. TEST[®] Use/ Differential Diagnosis

Dear Health Care Professional,

Your patients deserve a diagnosis, and T.R.U.E. TEST can help.

Allergic contact dermatitis is responsible for approximately half of all contact dermatitis cases. Patients with persistent, unresolved contact dermatitis can suffer for years with a diminished quality of life and increased medical treatment costs. However, the condition can be effectively treated once an accurate diagnosis is obtained. Patch testing is a simple procedure to help diagnose allergic contact dermatitis and identify the causative agent(s).

T.R.U.E. TEST (Thin Layer Rapid Use Epicutaneous Test) is a ready-to-use patch test for the diagnosis of allergic contact dermatitis (ACD) in patients whose history suggests a sensitivity to one or more of the substances included on the T.R.U.E. TEST[®] panels.

Did you know that T.R.U.E. TEST may also be used adjunctively to evaluate other eczemas (atopic, seborrheic, venous, palmar, and plantar hyperkeratotic eczema, vesiculosis, or neurodermatitis) and other dermatologic diseases that do not heal, such as leg ulcers and psoriasis, to determine whether there may be a contact hypersensitivity component.

Patch testing with T.R.U.E. TEST can be indicated for patients with:

- Persistent and recalcitrant dermatitis
- Suspected contact dermatitis
- Dorsal or patchy hand dermatitis
- Leg and foot dermatitis
- Facial dermatitis (excluding seborrheic)
- Discoid dermatitis
- Dermatitis with unusual distribution
- Atypical allergic symptoms
- Skin reactions from allergen ingestion
